

Worship Service – 10:00 a.m.

This is a said Worship Service with music, using The Holy Eucharist: Rite Two with contemporary language from *The Book of Common Prayer*.

The Worship Service has two parts. First, The Word of God, which consists of an Old Testament reading, a Psalm reading, a New Testament reading, a Gospel reading, Sermon, Prayers of The People, and Confession of Sin. The second part, is The Holy Communion, the receiving of the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

All baptized Christians who believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament , and practice your faith in your own church, are welcome to come forward to receive Holy Communion (to share in the Lord's Supper).

Those not receiving Holy Communion are invited to come to the rail, cross their arms, and receive a blessing.
