

## **Worship Service – 7:30 a.m.**

**This is a said Worship Service with no music, using The Holy Eucharist: Rite One with traditional language from *The Book of Common Prayer*.**

**The Worship Service has two parts. First, The Word of God, which consists of an Old Testament reading, a Psalm reading, a New Testament reading, a Gospel reading, Sermon, Prayers of The People, and Confession of Sin. The second part, is The Holy Communion, the receiving of the Body and Blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ.**

***All baptized Christians who believe in the Real Presence of Christ in the Blessed Sacrament , and practice your faith in your own church, are welcome to come forward to receive Holy Communion ( to share in the Lord's Supper ).***

***Those not receiving Holy Communion are invited to come to the rail, cross their arms, and receive a blessing.***
